Fashion designer Dinh Bá presents his fall-winter collection 2007-2008.

Montreal, March 21, 2007 – Montreal fashion designer Dinh Bá unveils his fall-winter 2007-2008 collection as part of his fourth participation in Montreal Fashion Week. In a flamboyant gesture, Dinh Bá Nguyen professes to be embracing eclecticism this season: an iridescent, crumpled, pierced world where scraps and patchwork mix with taffetas and checks.

Guided by a warm and comforting autumnal palette, Dinh Bá uses luminescent brown, silvery grey, copper, crimson and fuchsia, thumbing his nose at the gloomy days to follow. The elegant crumpled taffetas, fine laces and provocative chiffons are placed alongside glen plaid, denims with oversewn seams and micro-ribbed corduroys... a remarkable marriage of textures that produces powerful, original combinations.

Known for the structure of his garments, Dinh Bá has outdone himself this season as dresses and jackets steal the spotlight with their audacious volume and skilful contrast of fluid and rigid shapes. The box pleated skirt, deconstructed jackets and knits shape the silhouette, while balloon sleeves, asymmetrical collars and laces bespeak a surreal morphology. A gentle invitation to rebelliousness.
